His school, the Furniture Institute of Massachusetts, offers hands-on classes in all facets of traditional furniture making. He has been involved with woodworking since 1968 and is the author of many articles in "Fine Woodworking Magazine". He will be teaching the art of traditional chair making. No matter the style of chair you want to make, the techniques are the same. Phil will show us how to design, build and fit a chair as he actually constructs the parts and assembles one on stage. 
