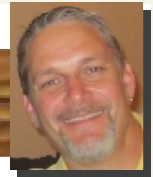

The Association By-Laws call for our election to be held at the Annual Meeting. This year, the meeting will be held 28 November. The nominees for officers for the coming year are as follows:

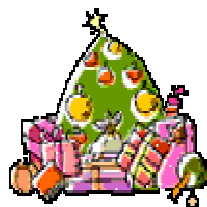
**President:** James LaGrone

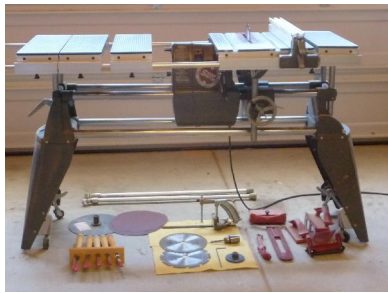

More Info: At this time we are trying to find a good table saw to replace the one they have that is in need of many repairs. We are hoping to find a person, or a company, that might donate a good table saw.

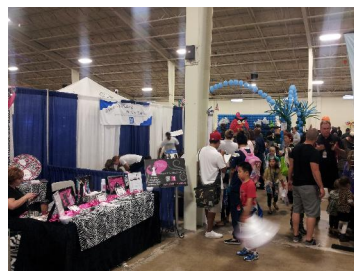

I look forward to your participation in our Grand Annual Event. I will provide additional information as the time gets closer. The theme for this year is: "GAME ON." "The 2013 San Diego County Fair theme is Game On! This theme will focus on classic board games, video game history and culture, the connection between board games and video games, and the future of the game industry. The exhibit will explore our love of engaging in competition through the game format, family fun, careers in the game industry, and the process of bringing a game to market."

The first meeting of the Planning Committee for Design in Wood will be Saturday, January 5, 2013, 9:30am, at Chuck Anderson's house.

### *Personal note from Bob Stevenson, SD County Fair, Coordinator, Design in Wood*

It was 1986 when I first attended the Del Mar Fair and the Design in Wood Exhibit. I was impressed by what the San Diego Fine Woodworkers Association was doing. In 1987, as a new member of SDFWA, I volunteered to help set up the exhibit. I also entered my first piece and helped to staff the exhibit. I recognized that this was a great venue to show craftsmanship and become actively involved with the Design in Wood Committee.

In 1995, after working with Pat Edwards and the committee for nine (9) years, I was offered the opportunity to take over the supervision of Design in Wood when Pat stepped down. I have thoroughly enjoyed my tenure and feel extremely privileged to have served the Association as the Exhibit Coordinator and Chair of the Shows and Exhibit Committee.

This year I was informed by the SDFWA Board that they expected me to provide them a two-year notice of my departure from this position. In August 2012 I officially notified the Board that my tenure as Coordinator would end with the close of the 2014 Design in Wood Exhibit.

In order to provide a smooth transition, we need to recruit a replacement as soon as possible. I would recommend that the person have a background or interest in Decorative Arts, Woodworking, and basic leadership skills. In addition to representing SDFWA, the position requires that the individual be interviewed and hired by the Fairgrounds. The management at the Fairgrounds requires a one-year of understudy to fully understand the position.

If you are personally interested in the position or can recommend someone, please notify me or any Board member immediately because whoever takes over the position needs to be involved with the 2013 exhibit. This is a State paid position and requires attending monthly meetings at the Fairgrounds October through May and working the exhibit May through July.

The Association would be best served if the Coordinator is a member of SDFWA.

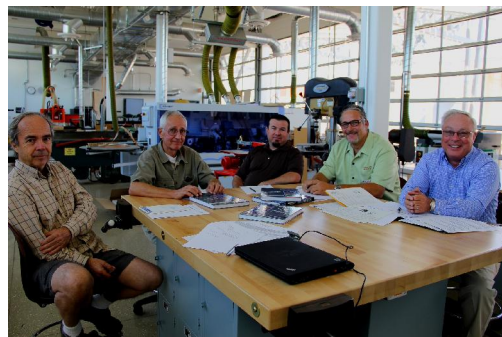
