Early American Life Magazine has listed Robert Stevenson as an artisan in its Directory of Early Traditional Crafts in their 2017 July/August issue. A photo (shown below) of one of Bob's many fine works is featured in their magazine. Bob used Honduran mahogany with holly, ebony, and satinwood inlays to craft this reproduction of a Federal game table, likely made in Salem, Massachusetts, c. 1800-10. The table stands 36 inches high, opens to 36 inches deep, and has a secret drawer behind the swing leg.


