

They have promised a demo of sawing on their bandsaw mill or Lucas mill.


Jessica will also explain the technique of resin infill and construction of some of their Design In Wood entries.

# **Design in Wood Exhibition Report**

Planning has already begun for the 2019 San Diego Fair and the San Diego Fine Woodworker's Design in Wood (DIW) exhibition. The 2019 theme is "<u>The Wizard of Oz</u>". It's not too early to start designing your 2019 entry. Time flies by fast. Remember to leave enough time to apply and cure your finish. The one common thing that separates winners is the finish. There are many opportunities for SDFWA members to get an award. Entries will open late January or early February.

I reported on SDFWA winners in the July newsletter. Here is some overall information from last year's San Diego Fair and Design in Wood Exhibition.

One discipline that needs more entries is furniture or art designed and made by CNC and/or Laser. Class 007 - "*Furniture Designed and Created by Computer – Laser and/or CNC*" ONLY had 2 entries. Class 015 - "*Veneering/Marquetry Art – Designed & Created by Computer Laser and/or CNC*" had only 4 entries (and 3 were from the same entrant). I expect to see more entries next year with the addition of the CNC and Laser capabilities in our Member Shop.

# 2018 Fall Seminar Report

We just completed our annual Fall Seminar with Garrett Hack as our guest speaker. I am pleased to report that by all accounts it was a rousing success. Garrett was engaging, entertaining and full of energy. He spent Friday evening showing and explaining his approach and philosophy of woodworking. Besides seeing examples of his work, we learned about his farm and how he harvests much of the wood he uses. He spent the rest of the weekend lecturing and building a small cabinet almost entirely by hand. He used the band saw only once to fit the stiles to the cabinet. He came prepared with enough parts already made, so he could show some of the hand work without boring us with repetitive cutting of parts. He had all the mortises premade and left just one that he could demonstrate. He was well prepared and kept moving along with each step. This is the first time a speaker actually finished a project during the weekend. He not only completed the assembly, he finished the cabinet with a fresh coat of shellac. His attention to detail is incredible. He showed us how to decorate a simple cabinet with details like the banded inlay down the sides, the molding at the top, and enhance it with a simple addition of a small molding. He invited us all up on stage and to look at and feel his tools. He encouraged people to see and feel his tools. He was very open to questions and I was particularly impressed by how he could continue to talk while working. That kept all of us engaged in what he was doing. It made for a very enjoyable weekend. We all certainly learned a lot about hand work and how to enhance a simple cabinet with very simple decoration that can be made in a very short time with simple tools. He showed us how to make the crown molding at the top of the cabinet with hand planes, rasps and very little sandpaper. One of the tools he frequently uses is the small scraping tool he used to make and finish the various moldings. (He taught us how to make and sharpen various scraper blades). He sells this tool for \$40. He ran out at the seminar, but he will sell it to our members, postage paid. Send your order to Garrett Hack, abundance.farm.vt@gmail.com.

Besides the many door prizes that were donated by Mike Durlak from Rockler Woodworking, we sold tickets for a special raffle at the end of the seminar. The proceeds will go to Rockler, who in turn will use the funds to provide pen kits and turning equipment to the "Turnaround for VETS" program put on by the San Diego Wood Turners. This year, in addition to the cabinet, we had a Porter Cable Router set donated by Rockler and an autographed copy of one of Garrett's books, "*The* HANDPLANE *Book*" donated by one of our members. I am pleased to report that we raised \$1100 for the program this year. Pictures of the winners are below:

Up to three (3) pieces may be accepted into the exhibition.

Subject line "WOOD X" Images should be send by deadline **December 11, 2018** submission should include jpg format images of the entire piece as well as a close-up. Clearly label each image with the artist's name, title of the piece and type of wood. CDs will not be returned. Do not send the actual piece. Enclose entry fee with CD. Make checks payable to EAP. You can also pay by phone 760 480 4101.

#### GENERAL PRESENTATION REQUIREMENTS

We strive to protect your work. To prevent possible damage to it artwork must be appropriately prepared for exhibition when delivered. Work that fails to comply with entry requirements will be disqualified upon discovery. If you anticipate that your work requires atypical hanging or display techniques, or if you simply aren't sure, please contact the Gallery prior to delivery dates for clearance. Display and/or lighting requirements will be at the discretion of the Gallery.
