### **SDFWA Newsletter**

Beginning in 1982 SDFWA has published a printed newsletter to help keep people informed of the activities and benefits of the Association, and to share information about woodworking related subjects. About 15 years ago, we also began posting each newsletter edition on the SDFWA website. Since then, the number of printed subscriptions has slowly decreased, and recently fell below the threshold to qualify for discounted bulk mailing rates. We now have fewer than 200 members who receive the printed newsletter.

When a \$5 annual fee for receiving a printed newsletter by mail was introduced several years ago, it was intended to help cover some of the ongoing costs for printing, assembly, and postage. SDFWA currently spends about \$2800/year to print and distribute 200 copies of the newsletter – or \$14 per subscription. As the number of these subscriptions continues to decrease, the Board is questioning whether or not we should continue to print the newsletter or switch completely to on-line distribution. We especially want the opinions of members who currently receive the newsletter by USPS mail.

We have multiple options – continue the current policy, increase the annual subscription fee to cover more or all of the printing and distribution costs, try to further reduce costs, or dispense with the printed version and move to on-line delivery only.

Many organizations like ours have discontinued printed newsletters and rely entirely on electronic distribution channels. However, we think some of you may want to continue to receive a printed newsletter. Please let your Board know what options you would consider by completing the newsletter survey at <a href="https://goo.gl/forms/DzSb9AowtwwTTZfy1">https://goo.gl/forms/DzSb9AowtwwTTZfy1</a> or returning the included printed version by mail or in person at the next General Meeting.

The printed newsletter will continue at least through 2019. We will keep you informed as decisions are made.
