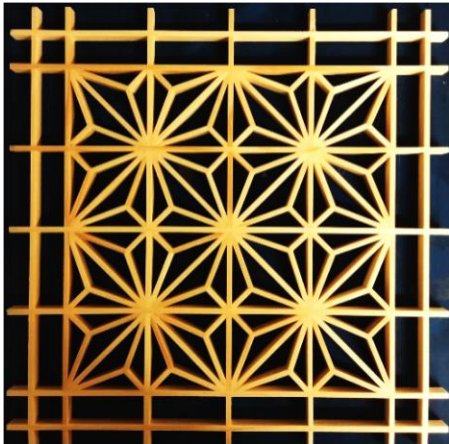

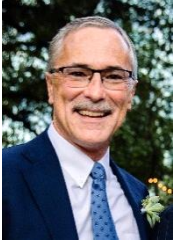

THE 2019 Design In Wood Exhibition

It looks like another banner year for the Design in Wood exhibition. We have 372 entries from 217 exhibitors, (our second highest!) To give you an idea of how entries come in, on Tuesday, April 22nd we had 158 entries and by that Friday's deadline at midnight we had 372 entries.

By the time you get this it will be past the time to have your tickets mailed, but you can still volunteer and pick up your free fair tickets at will call. We need your help, especially on the 1PM - 4PM shift at the end of the fair. We still have openings for floor walkers, especially toward the end of the fair. It appears that the shop slot incentive worked well for filling volunteer floor walkers. We only have a few spots left for the chair shop. Thank you all for volunteering. Remember this is your show and you should be proud to show it to the public and get them interested in woodworking. It's a great opportunity to sign up new SDFWA Members. (They get a discount if they sign up at the fair). Volunteering is very rewarding, and NO experience is necessary. Help is needed with set-up starting Monday, May 13 at the fairgrounds Mission Tower building. Enter the Solana gate and park near the building, (parking may be restricted after the 13th). Bring a screw gun, (if you have one). There is a lot to do. We have Marines to do the heavy lifting. In addition to free fair tickets, enjoy coffee, juice and donuts in the morning and a great lunch and refreshments throughout the day. Come in and find any of our staff (those are the ones with employee badges) and they will get you signed up and put you to work. If you have problems, seek me out and I will find something for you to do.
